**The proposed incorporation of

FINAL ORDER

WHEREAS the Director of the Department of Labor & Economic Growth signed an Order on June 19, 2006, to approve a petition which proposed that certain territory in Crystal Township be incorporated as the Village of Crystal Lake.

WHEREAS more than 5% of the registered electors in the area approved for the proposed incorporation have signed and filed a valid petition with the State Boundary Commission within the statutory 45-day period asking for a referendum election on the proposed incorporation, as authorized in Public Act 191 of 1968, as amended. The referendum petition signatures were declared to be legally sufficient at a Boundary Commission meeting held on August 17, 2006.

IT IS ORDERED THAT the registered electors in the territory proposed to be incorporated shall vote on the referendum question at an election to be held on November 7, 2006. If a majority of the electorate in the territory proposed for incorporation, voting collectively on the referendum question, approve the incorporation process to continue, this Order shall become final on the date specified herein. The new effective date for the Summary of Proceedings, Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and Final Order that was signed by the Director on June 19, 2006, shall be November 21, 2006, and a copy of this Order, and the Canvass of Votes from the election of November 7, 2006, shall be appended thereto.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the attached ballot language (Attachment A) shall be used. The clerk of either the Township of Crystal or the County of Montcalm shall print the ballots for the election; the clerk shall conduct and direct the election in compliance with the election laws of this state; the Montcalm County Board of Canvassers shall certify the election results to the State Boundary Commission; and, the local unit of government shall pay the expense of the election.
